28th Anniversary Service in Alhuey

Although there are still some unfinished projects, the extra space is entirely usable. It provides the necessary room for the growing number of people coming to our services from ten surrounding towns.

Tap usually preaches once a month, and Denise shares playing the piano with grandson **Jesed** and **Jimena**, a talented young teenager from the youth group. Jimena is joined by several other teens who bless our services with our "<u>mini orchestra</u>"!

Tap has resumed preaching twice a week at two different drug rehabilitation centers. He also is active in organizing pastors' meetings with our sister churches in Sinaloa. We now have the freedom to travel and support other ministries.

We arrived at <u>Campamento</u> <u>Meta</u> in Morelia, Michocán, on June 6 to begin our 11th year of serving there. We will stay until the end of August. We just finished a Father's Day retreat for 100 men, including their sons and staff.



At camp, we assist with basic maintenance and help in the store and outdoor kitchen, as well as teaching divided sessions during 5 weeks of youth camp, serving 250 youth each week! It is an honor to serve alongside faithful staff and members of La Iglesia Bautista Esperanza and Pastor Radamés Gil.

Ministry to South Asia

Tap has between 6-8 weekly Zoom or WhatsApp meetings with five groups of pastors, a discipleship class with young men from Pakistan, an informal Bible Institute with faithful couples from India and occasional invitations to preach to inquiring souls in private homes with 5-30 persons.

Tap preached to a Buddhist family in their home. (<u>Message</u>) Since then, the family has been assisting **G.'s** home church!



This afternoon we held a prayer service, and many people came to listen to the Word of God. Thank the Lord for your prayers. -- Pastor C. in his church.




